1. Unless otherwise specified, work for a requirement or an elective can be started at any time. Ask your Trainmaster or Sr. Leaders to help you learn the things you need to know or do.

You should read the material on the subject, study , and practice.

2. Show Your Stuff. When you are ready, let your Trainmaster or Sr. Leaders know you want to meet the requirements. This can be dont at a Pioneer meeting, camp, or at a scheduled time.

When you go, take along the things you will need to meet the requirements. (Materials, Drawings, Pictures, Reports, Examples) Your Leaders will ask you to do each requirement to make sure that you know your stuff and have done or can do the things required

3. Get your recognition. When your Leaders are satisfied that you have met each requirement, he or she will record your achievement. After meeting requirements for a Rank or

Concentration you will receive your recognition to be placed on your walking stick and/or plaque.

4. Requirements. You will be expected to meet the requirements as they are stated. You will be expected to do exactly what is stated in the requirements. If the requirement says show Concentration you will receive your recognition to be placed on your walking stick and/or plaque. or demonstrate, that is what you must do. Just telling about will not be enough. The same thing holds true for such words as create, make, list, construct, in the field, collect, identify, label.

Additionally - boys would be able to tailor the program to their own specific interests by choosing different concentrations. Lapel pins to place on their walikng stick would be made available for each concentration when completed.
