Fire Building Level 3 - Lesson Plan

Key Points to Cover:

1 – Starting a fire without matches: Rotating stick method, flint and striker
2 – Types of Fires: Lean-To Fire
Supplies Suggested:
Bring in wood to actually build the fire as an example. Physically construct the fires taking time to show how each layer is constructed for proper air flow and flame travel is key.
Activities to Reinforce Lesson:
Construct a stick and bow assembly to have kids try and start a fire with this method. This should be done outside even though it takes to start a fire with this method, smoke comes on early.
Using a flint and striker, start a fire for the group using tinder. Kids can try this if there is enough supervision.
Devotion:
